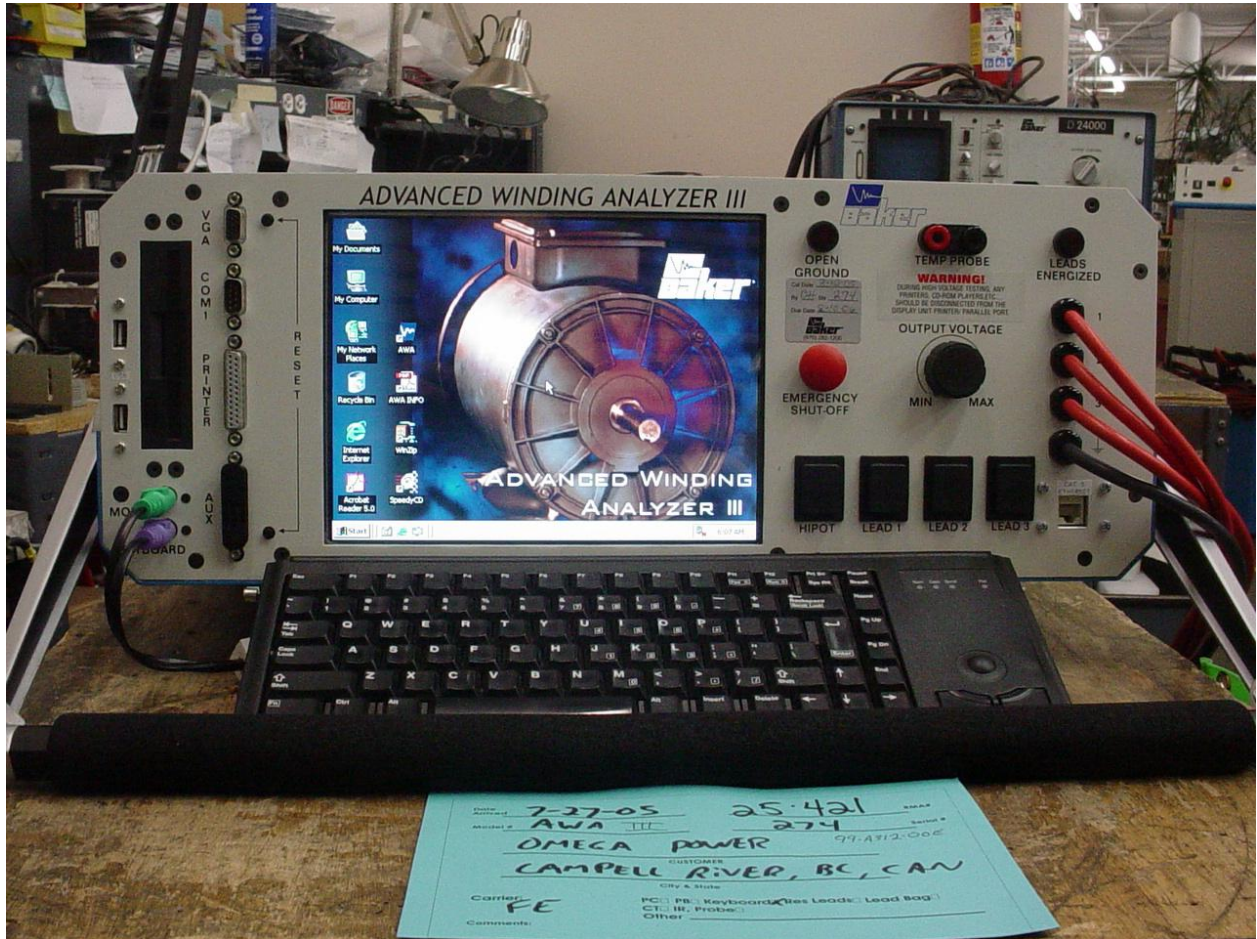


Baker AWA-III



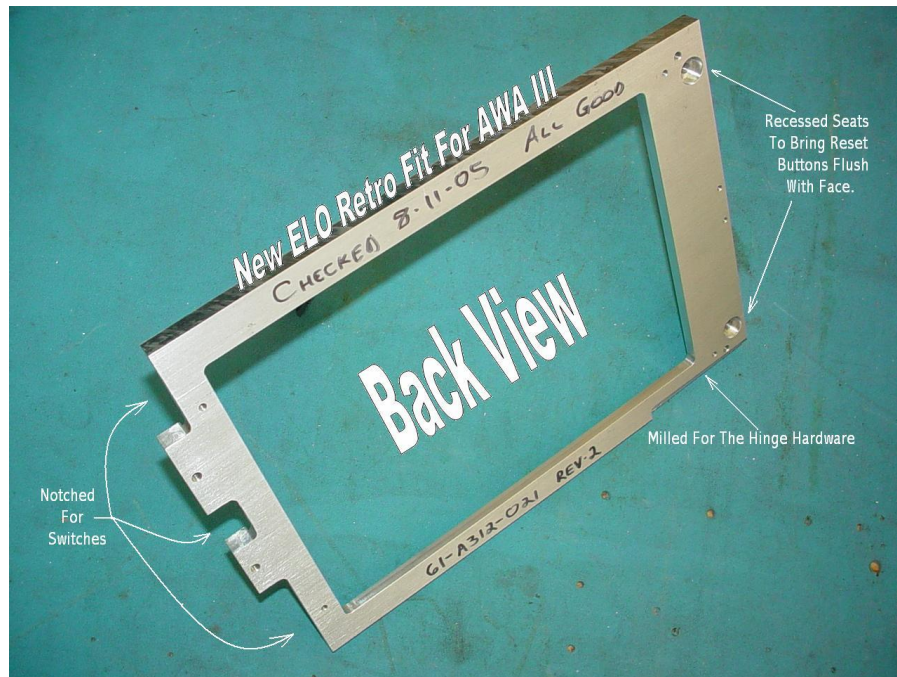
This was an old AWA-III That I upgraded back in 2005. With a new faster SBC Motherboard and a new Hard drive with an updated Operating System

Addition of USB ports and a CAT-5 port as well



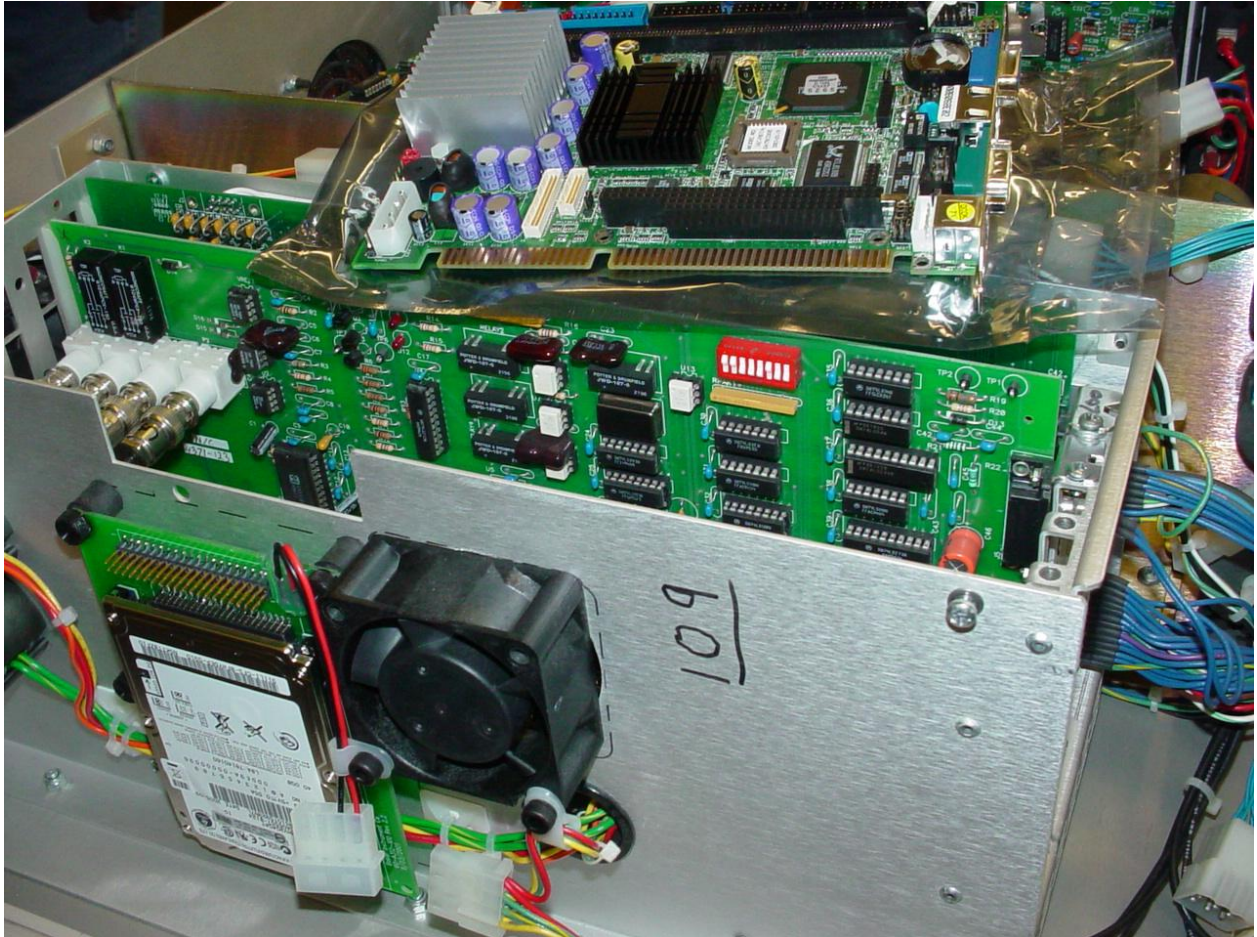
When upgrading these old testers I took the customer request and incorporated it in to the re-design of all upgrades.

New LCD Bezel



I designed a new LCD Bezel to incorporate a touch screen in front of the LCD. Back in 2005 a touch screen was cutting edge for a tester.

New Motherboard and Hard Drive



With this new SBC I was able to eliminate the old VGA to TFT card configuring the new TFT connection directly from the SBC.

Because some of the old full sized IDE Hard Drives were getting broken heads when the operators would tip the testers over, I had a mounting plate adaptor built for the much more durable mobile laptop drive. Than I would install the whole assembly on shock mounts.
